Terms & conditions (*submission of bids will be taken as acceptance of these terms and conditions*)

1. Only members of the Revenue Society (including those newly joining) may bid.
2. The highest bidder wins the lot. In the event of tied bids, limits will be increased as authorised by bidders. If there is still a tie, the bid received first will secure the lot.
3. Bidding steps (non-standard bids will normally be rounded down):
0- £10 steps of 50p £10-£20 steps of £1 £20-£50 steps of £2
£50-£100 steps of £5 £100+ steps of £10 or at the Auctioneer's discretion
4. The highest bidder will secure the lot at one step above the second highest, or at reserve if there is no other bid. All lots have reserves of at least 70% of estimate.
5. Scans of most lots are available on request.
6. Payment may be made by any of the methods shown on the front of the bid form. Bidders wishing to pay using foreign currency cash (euro or US dollar) may do so on the understanding that any bank charges, commission and exchange conversion losses will be borne by the bidder. The exchange rate will be as determined by the Auctioneer.
7. Unless payment is made in advance, successful bidders will receive a pro-forma invoice payable within 7 days of receipt. An administration charge of £20 will be made for payments remitted more than 30 days after invoicing, and lots may be forfeited at the auctioneer's discretion. Returned cheques will also incur a £20 charge.
8. Postage is charged at cost. Recorded Delivery / International Tracked and Signed is used for packages over £50, and Special Delivery for packages over £100. Consignments worth more than the Royal Mail's maximum will be split into two or more packets for despatch unless the buyer instructs otherwise.
9. We may be required to complete a UK Customs Declaration on packages sent overseas.
10. Packing is charged at a flat rate of 25p per lot.
11. There is no VAT charge and no buyers' premium.
